PROGRAM NOTES

The Festival of Nine Lessons and Carols is a format for a liturgical service celebrating the birth of Jesus. The story of the fall of Adam and Eve, the promise of a coming Messiah, and the birth of Jesus is told in nine short Biblical readings from the Book of Genesis, the Prophetic Books and the Gospels, interspersed with the singing of Christmas carols, hymns and sacred music.

The format was based on an Order of Worship drawn up by the Archbishop of Canterbury for use on Christmas Eve in 1880. Tradition says that he organized a 10 pm service in a temporary wooden shed serving as his Cathedral. The original liturgy has since been adapted and used by other churches all over the world. At Pius XI Catholic High School, Lessons and Carols has been a tradition dating back to the 1990s. For all of those years, we have presented our program at the beautiful center of our Archdiocese, here at the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist. This year, we are honored to have Reverend Ken Knippel from St. John Vianney Parish, and Reverend Tony Zimmer from St. Anthony on the Lake Parish (and former Pius XI Chaplain) as our Presiders. They are both tireless advocates of Catholic Education and true friends to Pius XI. We are so blessed to have them with us this evening, and to have them as leaders in our Archdiocese. We are also grateful to Mr. Michael Batcho, Director of Music at the Cathedral, and Mr. Scott Eakins, Director of Liturgy & Communications, for their help and support.

Tonight our program will feature our special guests, the Master Singers of Milwaukee, under the direction of Dr. Eduardo Garcia-Novelli and the Christmas at the Cathedral Choir, under the direction of Emily Crocker. Dr. Garcia-Novelli also serves as the Director of Choral Activities at Carthage College. Ms. Crocker has devoted her long career to choral music, and in addition to her work in the Pius XI Performing Arts Academy, serves as Vice President of Choral Publications for Hal Leonard Publishing.

A special thank you to former adjunct faculty member, Paula Foley Tillen, and guest conductor Emily Crocker. Paula is the composer of "Adam Lay Y Bounden" which will receive its world premiere in the program this evening, and the Christmas Choir will perform two of Emily's arrangements on our program. We are honored to present these contemporary settings, and blessed to have such rich talent in our community.

We are led, by a babe in a humble manger, to the miracle of Christmas. This miracle hinges on faith and trust. The faith of a young and frightened Mary, approached by the angel Gabriel, chosen by the virtue of her trust in God, decides at great personal risk, to be the lynch pin of salvation history. As humble Bethlehem, by virtue of the coronation of King David, was chosen to become the birthplace of our Savior, and as the Archbishop of Canterbury chose a humble shed as the birthplace of the beautiful Lessons and Carols, so too, Pius XI, by virtue of its Catholic faith and trust in the Holy Spirit, has been chosen to serve the Lord by nurturing and caring for His children. Children, who like the babe in the manger, lead us to the miracle of Christmas.

She holds degrees from the University of North Texas and Texas Woman's University, and has done additional study at UNT (choral conducting), Westminster Choir College (conducting and voice-building), TWU (vocal pedagogy) and Sam Houston State University (Kodaly methods).

THE MILWAUKEE FESTIVAL BRASS

Founded in 1985, Milwaukee Festival Brass is an exciting brass ensemble made up of volunteer brass and percussion players from all walks of life, both young and old from all over Southeastern Wisconsin. Led by its highly regarded Director, **Mark A. Taylor**, they have added their own unique flair to a repertoire ranging from classics to contemporary selections using traditional British Brass Band instruments.
